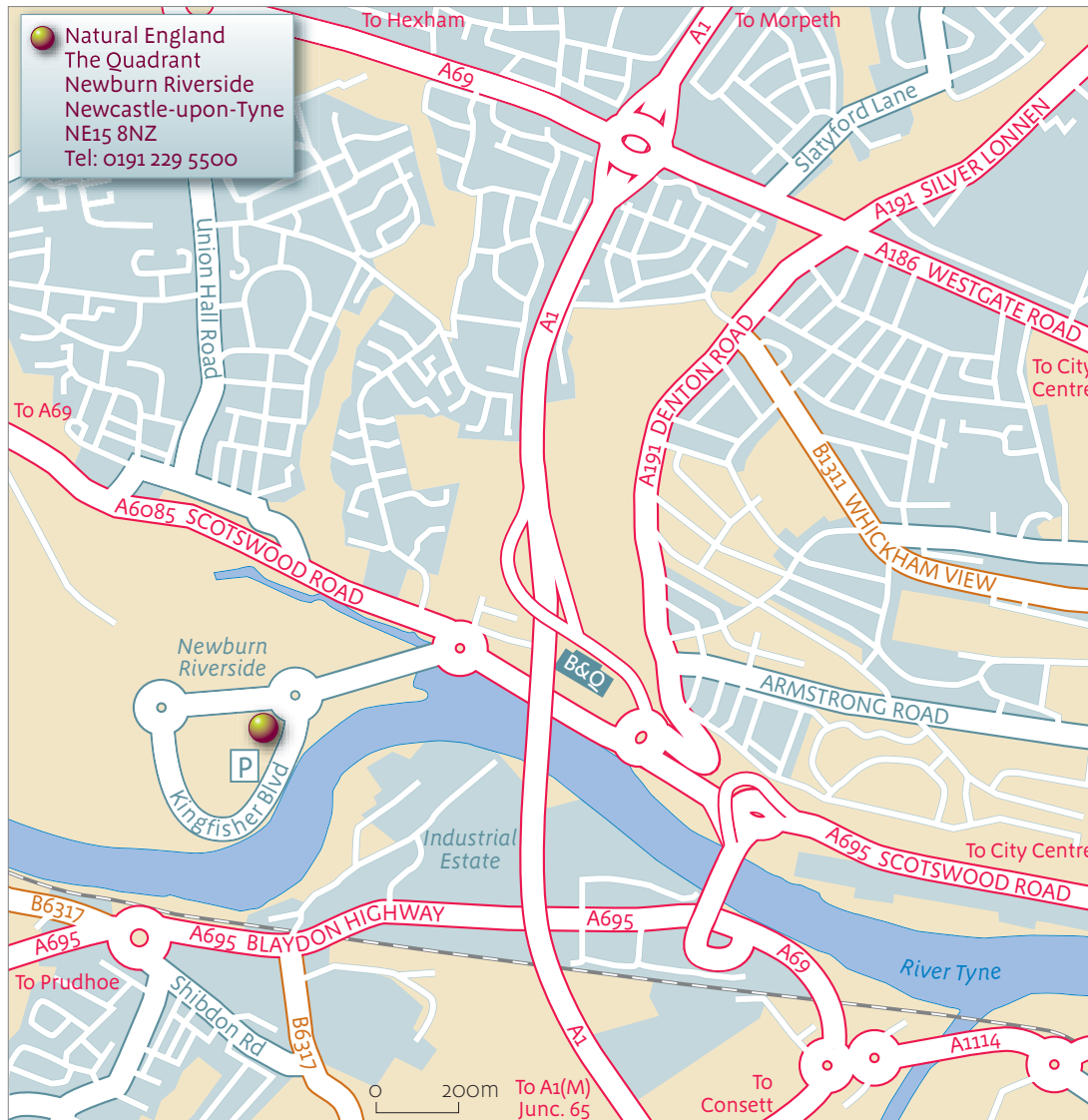

HOW TO GET TO US

By public transport

From Newcastle Central railway station, the X23 bus leaves every 30 minutes and stops just past The Quadrant. The 22 bus to Throckley leaves the station every 10 minutes, and stops on Scotswood Road after passing B&Q, a 5 minute walk to the office. Taxis take 10-15minutes.

By car

From the North:

Follow the A1 until you reach a turnoff signposted City Centre A695; Blaydon, Newburn, A6085. Take this road and at the bottom of the hill turn right onto the A6085. After passing B&Q on your right, the road passes under the A1 and Newburn Riverside is the first left at the roundabout. The Quadrant is the blue building facing you.

From the South:

After passing over the River Tyne, leave the A1 at the A69 Hexham turnoff. Circuit the roundabout and rejoin the A1 southbound, then leave at the next exit. Follow directions as from the north.

Disabled access

There are lifts to all floors, and easy access to reception from the car park. Facilities are on the ground and second floor.
